
The New Riverside Public School Located at 250 William St., Elmira is Open

Crossing guard times and locations have been adjusted as follows. There will be a crossing guard at the intersection of **Church St. and Arthur St. from 8:35-9:05am and 3:40-4:10pm** as there has been in the past. However, there will no longer be a crossing guard at Church St. West and Dunke St. This crossing has moved to **Church St. West and Country Club Estates Drive from 8:40-9:10am and 3:30-4:00pm**. For the first two weeks of school there will be two guards at this site, to give children and parents a chance to learn the routine.



We know You're out there ... Spare Crossing Guards needed for 2016-2017

The Township of Woolwich employs eight dedicated School Crossing Guards. Occasionally, our Crossing Guards must be absent from work so a roster of Spare Crossing Guards is maintained to cover absences. We are currently seeking **four (4) community-minded individuals** with flexible schedules to work periodically during the coming school year. Ideal candidates must be at least 18 years old, able to work in all types of weather conditions, and with access to transportation. It is essential that candidates enjoy working with children. Previous experience working with students is an asset.

Spare Crossing Guards choose the schools they will serve. The schools that are served by Crossing Guards are: Riverside Public School in Elmira; John Mahood Public School in Elmira; St. Jacobs Public School; Conestogo Public School; St. Boniface Separate School in Maryhill; and Breslau Public School. When called upon, a Spare Crossing Guard may accept or decline an offered shift. Each shift accepted by a Spare Crossing Guard involves a 30-minute duty time either before or after school. This is a paid position that would be enjoyed by a retired individual. All training and equipment is provided. A police background check is a condition of employment.
